

- 3.) <u>Pre-Build:</u> If included in the specifications, a pre-build conference will be conducted to ascertain and confirm customer requirements with respect to the Ambulance ordered by Buyer. Both parties agree that the pre-build conference will be conducted no later than thirty (30) business days from execution of this Agreement.
- **4.)** <u>Delivery:</u> The Ambulance shall be delivered F.O.B. to Buyer within 140 calendar days after execution of this Agreement by Buyer and the receipt and execution of same by the Company.



It is agreed that such delivery is subject to delays caused by war, acts of god, hurricane, labor shortages or strikes, inability to obtain materials, and other causes reasonably beyond the control of the Company and that the Company will not be liable for, and this Agreement may not be terminated on account of, such delays. Buyer will be notified no less than fourteen (14) business days in advance of the delivery date.

- 5.) Final Inspection Customer Factory Inspection: If requested at time of order, Buyer will have up to ten (10) business days from the notified completion date to conduct Buyer's final factory inspection. Otherwise, delivery will be deemed to occur on the notified inspection date. In the event that Buyer fails to make inspection of the Ambulance on the notified completion date (or within the ten (10) business day period thereafter, if applicable), Company reserves the right to arrange for shipment of the Ambulance to the dealer by the drive-away service of Company's choice, and to charge the Customer the full invoice price for the Ambulance, which shall be paid for in the manner specified in paragraph 2.
- **6.)** Buyer's Cancellation for Convenience. If Buyer tenders any cancellation hereunder, Buyer shall nevertheless accept delivery of all products which are completed at the time of cancellation. Those products which constitute work-in-process inventory at the time of cancellation shall be paid for by Buyer at a price equal to the completed percentage of the product multiplied by the price specified in Paragraph 2. Buyer also shall pay promptly to Company the costs of settling and paying claims arising out of the termination of work under Company's subcontracts or vendors, plus an additional 15% to defray Company's accounting, legal, and clerical costs arising out of the cancellation.
- 7.) <u>Title:</u> The Company and Buyer agree that the Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin shall remain with the Company until the Company has been paid in full. Provided that the Company has been paid in full, the Certificate of Origin shall remain with the Company until the Ambulance leaves Company premises in the physical custody of the Buyer. Certificate of Origin will be sent to customer within ten business days after pick up of vehicle. Upon pick up by Buyer, responsibility for title application, ownership and risk of loss shall pass from Company to Buyer.
- **8.)** Warranty: The Company warrants each new Ambulance manufactured against defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year from the in-service date per the Warranty Registration Card. Warranties beyond one year may be applicable to certain components of the Ambulance as described in the Statements of Warranty previously provided to the Buyer. This warranty is in favor of the original user/purchaser, in accordance with the Company's preprinted Statements of Warranty which are either attached to the Agreement or have otherwise been delivered to Buyer. Buyer hereby acknowledges receipt of the Company's preprinted Statements of Warranty.

With respect to any Ambulance not manufactured by the Company, such items shall not be warranted by the Company but shall be subject to the warranty provided by the manufacturer.

These warranties are in lieu of all other warranties, whether express or implied, and THE COMPANY EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER SUCH WARRANTIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.



- **9.)** Notices: The parties to this Agreement designate Yankton County, SD as representative of the Buyer and Fire Safety USA, Inc. as representative of the Company for purposes of all communications regarding this Agreement.
- **10.)** Waiver of Jury Trial: The parties to this Agreement agree that any dispute arising hereunder, if brought before a court having proper jurisdiction, shall be adjudicated in a bench trial and the parties expressly waive any right to have such matter(s) tried before a jury.
- 11.) Entire Agreement: This Agreement, including its attachments and exhibits, constitutes the entire understanding between the parties relating to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior discussions and Agreements. No agent or representative of the Company has authority to make any representations, statements, warranties or Agreements not herein expressed and all modifications or amendments of this Agreement, including its attachments and exhibits, must be in writing signed by an authorized representative of each of the parties hereto.
- **12.)** Acceptance by Company: This Agreement shall not constitute a valid and binding obligation of the Company until accepted in writing by an officer of the Company at its offices in Rochester, Minnesota. When requested by the Company, the Buyer shall furnish a satisfactory written opinion of the Buyer's attorney that the Buyer has the power to make the Agreement, that the individual signing is authorized to sign on behalf of the Buyer, and that this Agreement is a valid, legal and enforceable obligation of the Buyer.





- 1. No such variance shall be recommended for approval by the Planning Commission unless it finds:
 - A. The strict application of the ordinance would produce undue hardship; <u>The property is forty-five (45.23) acres in a Low Density Rural Residential District. The lot size is sufficient to comply with yard requirements. The applicant is requesting the variance to properly provide storage space for personal property.</u>
 - B. Such hardship is not shared generally by other properties in the same zoning district and the same vicinity; *The hardship is not shared by other properties in the district.*
 - C. The authorization of such variance will not be of substantial detriment to adjacent property and the character of the district will not be changed by the grant of the variance; <u>The granting of a variance will not be of substantial detriment to adjacent property nor the character of the district.</u>
 - D. The granting of such variance is based upon reasons of demonstrable and exceptional hardship as distinguished from variations for purposed of convenience, profit, and caprice. *No convenience, profit or caprice was shown.*
- 2. No variance shall be recommended for approval unless the Planning Commission finds the condition or situation of the property concerning or the intended use of the property concerned, or the intended use of the property is not of so general or recurring a nature as to make reasonably practicable the formulation of a general regulation to be adopted as an amendment of this ordinance. The requested variance may be recurring sufficiently to provide remedy with a zoning amendment. The amendment process may begin in the next few months.
- 3. A recommendation of approval concerning a variance from the terms of this ordinance shall not be founded by the Planning Commission unless and until:
 - A. A written application for a variance is submitted demonstrating that special conditions and circumstances exist which are peculiar to the land, structure, or building involved and which are not applicable to other lands, structures, or buildings, in the same district; <u>The property is demonstrating special conditions or circumstances with size and location and is not applicable to other lands, structures, or buildings in the same district.</u>

- B. The literal interpretation of the provisions of this ordinance would deprive the applicant of rights commonly enjoyed by other properties in the same district under the terms of this ordinance; <u>Previous variances of maximum accessory structure size requirement have been granted in Yankton County.</u>
- C. The special conditions and circumstances do not result from the actions of the applicant; The special conditions and circumstances are not a result of the applicant.
- D. The granting of the variance requested will not confer on the applicant any special privilege that is denied by this ordinance to other lands, structure, or buildings in the same district. <u>Variance requests of this type (maximum accessory structure size requirement) have been previously denied by the Planning Commission.</u>
- 4. No nonconforming use of neighboring lands, structures, or buildings in the same district, and no permitted or nonconforming use of lands, structures, or buildings in other districts shall be considered grounds for the issuance of a variance. No nonconforming uses of neighboring lands, structures, or buildings in this district, and no permitted or nonconforming use of lands, structures, or buildings in other districts were considered.
- 5. Notice of public hearing shall be given, as in Section 1803 (3-5). The applicant mailed letters of notification to property owners within a one-quarter mile radius of the proposed variance on April 27, 2018 (supported by affidavit), a legal notice was published on April 28, 2018 in the Yankton Daily Press and Dakotan and a notification sign was placed on the property on May 1, 2018.
- 6. The public hearing shall be held. Any party may appear in person or by agent or by attorney. A public hearing was held at 7:45 pm on May 8, 2018. Mr. Kneifl stated his request for a variance to build an accessory structure forty-four (44) foot x seventy-two (72) foot with eleven, four inch (11'4") sidewalls, a 3,169 sq. ft. structure. This structure is 58% larger than the zoning district requirement. The materials will be earth tone colors, the structure meets the yard requirements, the site is selected to reduce view shed impact for the neighbors and the proposed size is reduced from previous applications.

Public comment for proponents was open. Amy Eichfeld sent a letter to the Planning & Zoning office. Mrs. Eichfeld stated her support for the application and it will be an asset to the community.

Public comment for opponents was open. Jerry Mueller discussed the orientation of the building and the materials are more appealing for a residential area. Mr. Mueller, felt the structure was an improvement from previous applications.

Lisa Huber stated the size is still larger than the zoning district requirements, the building aesthetics are improved and the lot size is sufficient.

Teresa McDermott sent a letter to the Planning & Zoning office. She stated concern regarding the total height of the structure at 27'6" and will be above the tree canopy. The will impact the view shed on the McDermott property. Mrs. McDermott suggest a building site on lower elevation property and not be intrusive to any of the neighbors.

The Planning Commission discussed the application. The structure is 58% larger than the regulation size of 2,000 sq. ft. The location is in close proximity of existing tree belts for screening. The building materials are compatible with a residential district. The property shows sufficient lot size and all yard setbacks are compliant. The Planning Commission does not have any jurisdiction regarding view sheds in residential neighborhoods.

No other comments, positive or negative, were received by the Zoning Administrator or presented at the public hearing.

- 7. The Planning Commission shall make findings that the requirements of this Section have been met by the applicant for a variance; the Commission shall further make a finding that the reasons set forth in the application justify the recommendations of granting the variance, and the variance is the minimum variance that will make possible the reasonable use of the land, building, or structure; the Planning Commission shall further make a finding that the granting of the variance will be in harmony with the general purpose and intent of this ordinance, and will not be injurious to the neighborhood, or otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

 The Planning Commission further finds that the reasons set forth in the application and hearing satisfy all requirements for this variance request.
- 8. In recommending approval of any variance, the Planning Commission may prescribe appropriate conditions and safeguards in conformity with this ordinance. *The Planning Commission approves this request.*
- 9. Under no circumstances shall the Planning Commission recommend granting a variance to allow a use not permissible under the terms of this ordinance in the district involved, or any use expressly or by implication prohibited by the terms of this ordinance in said district. <u>The variance request of Maximum Accessory Structure Size Requirement is approved.</u>



Hi Pat. Please let me know that you received this. I am unable to attend the public hearing tonight that will consider the variance for the Kneifl structure so I would like this to be read in my absence. Thanks.

To Yankton County Planning Commissioners:

My name is Teresa McDermott. I live at <u>43409 Kaiser Road</u>, on 5 acres directly North of the Kneifl property that is requesting a variance of maximum accessory structure size.

First, I'd like to acknowledge that Kelly Kneifl has communicated his plans of constructing an out building on his property and has made some modifications to his original plan in attempt to minimize obstructing our view of the lake. However, the peak height of the building has remained unchanged. The proposed building plans, with a peak height of 27'6", being placed on nearly the highest elevation location of his property, will certainly reach heights above the tree line and therefore be clearly visible to me and further block our line of sight to the lake. I have to assume that zoning ordinances are in place to protect the interests of all surrounding home owners, otherwise, why else would written notification of public hearing to surrounding property owners be required? I oppose approval of any variance that may negatively impact my property value.

We purchased our homestead in January 2017 and paid a premium in part because of the location and the scenic beauty it offered. I recognize the zoning ordinance may not protect views of the lake directly. However, we all know property values are affected by it's surroundings. I have no doubt Mr. Kneifl will keep his property looking beautiful, however, no structure he builds will be more beautiful than nature. This proposed building, because of the large size and excessive height, will most definitely significantly impact our views of nature. As in the last meeting when his similar variance request was voted down, I questioned why a building who's primary purpose is for storage and a workshop, is so deserving of a beautiful hilltop view, especially at the neighbor's expense when there are clearly other location options on his acreage. If this variance request is to be approved, it would set a precedence of other very large and tall buildings allowed near the lake area. Ideally I would like to see his structure placed at a lower elevation so that no neighbors view would be negatively impacted, and therefore, bare no negative impact to surrounding property values. I ask that you consider yourself in my situation and ask yourself if you would feel the same. I am simply asking that you follow the rules to protect the interests of all homeowners.







For the past 58 years, Aspire (formerly the Adjustment Training Center) has proudly served people from northeastern South Dakota with intellectual or developmental disabilities. As a result, the 160 people who we serve have more opportunities to live, work, and contribute to the community, as an alternative to institutional care.

Aspire receives the majority of funding through the SD Department of Human Services, however, these Medicaid resources are not enough, so we rely on other sources of support to supplement our budget. Each year, we ask that counties consider a contribution equal to the amount counties would pay if a person resided at the SD Development Center in Redfield (\$60 per month per person).

Many counties value the service we provide and contribute toward the program. I am hopeful Campbell County will continue to do the same. Based on the calculation above, I would ask the county to consider a contribution of \$1,440.00.
