April 7, 2015

Malt Beverage: Action on the 2015 Malt Beverage License application for Barton Bickley dba Lewis & Clark Meat Lodge, LLC was postponed to the next commission meeting.

Action 15131H: A motion was made by Epp and seconded by Bodenstedt to approve a Right of Way application submitted by Ron Miller. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Action 15132H: A motion was made by Kettering and seconded by Epp to approve a Right of Way application submitted by the City of Irene. All present voted aye; motion carried.

DOE: Yankton County Director of Equalization Lori Mackey appeared before the board to discuss the assessment and appeal process for board of equalization, which will be held April 14, 2015 in the commission chamber. Director Mackey also requested approval of the new job description for the temporary appraiser assistant position.

Action 15133DOE: A motion was made by Freng and seconded by Kettering to approve the new job description for the temporary appraiser. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Rail Authority: Commissioner Bodenstedt spoke to Secretary of Transportation Darin Bergquist, in regards to the County implementing a Regional Rail Authority in Yankton County. Bodenstedt said the Rail Authority would be in conjunction with Yankton City and would be a positive for Yankton County.

Action 15134C: A motion was made Kettering and seconded by Epp to initiate action to start a Regional Rail Authority. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Rail Park: Jeff Jones, representing Yankton Area Progressive Growth, said YAPG has been approached by Dakota Plains, with a possibility of building a grain facility at Napa Junction. Dakota Plains have asked YAPG to move forward with the development of a TID District, but added that does not mean that they have chosen Yankton County for the grain facility. Jones said YAPG is simply asking for a show of County support in moving forward with possibility of development of a TID District.

Action 15135C: A motion was made by Bodenstedt and seconded by Kettering to have the Planning Commission move forward with establishing a TID District for a Rail Park. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Red Cross: Tony Burke, Executive Director of American Red Cross appeared before the Board to introduce plans to increase community awareness of the danger of home fires, the Yankton Fire Department and the American Red Cross are planning a fire preparedness event Saturday, April 11. There will be volunteers canvassing certain high risk areas to distribute 10 year lithium battery smoke detectors in homes that do not have smoke alarms. The group will also be offering voluntary blood pressure checks to individuals.

Comprehensive Plan: Greg Henderson, Executive Director of Planning and Development District III (PDIII), presented to the board the Technical Assistance Agreement between Yankton County and Planning & Development District III.

Action 15142C: A motion was made by Kettering and seconded by Bodenstedt to accept the Technical Assistance Agreement with the cost being \$6,500.00. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Awards: Yankton County Ambulance Director Steve Hawkins and Robert Keys, representing the SD Office of EMS, appeared before the board to present the AHA "Heartsaver Hero Awards", to Yankton EMS, Yankton Search & Rescue, Yankton Police Department and the Irene First Responders. The above medical groups responded to two separate cardiac arrest calls that resulted in both patients surviving. Scott Hiltunen MD, YCEMS Medical Director stated in letter form, that outcomes like these are what EMS always strives for and through hard work, training and professionalism our team helped these people have a chance to see their families again.

County Health Insurance: Tara Stombaugh, Avera Health Plans representative for Yankton County's employee health insurance program, reviewed the current status of the policy and renewal terms. Stombaugh said the County's claim history has resulted in a 9.99% premium increase for the County in the year ahead. Currently the County pays \$542.29 per individual. With the 9.99% increase, the premium would be \$596.48.

Safety Center Bond: Thomas J. Grimmond of Dougherty & Company LLC presented the Commission an offer to underwrite refunding bonds concerning General Obligation Bonds for the Yankton County Safety Center.

E911: Individual was not able to attend the scheduled meeting.

Boys and Girls Club: Nancy Wenande, Secretary for the Boys & Girls Club of Yankton along with Tara Mills, Director of Development & Marketing, appeared before the board to present the club's plans for a permanent Boys & Girls Club facility in Yankton. With the new facility there would be a place for youth events, a teen center and increased level of service with longer hours to host both night and weekend programs. In an effort to accommodate more youth at the Boys & Girls Club, every capital dollar raised by the community will be matched by Larry and Diane Ness up to \$2 million, and every endowment dollar raised will be matched up to \$1 million by First Dakota National Bank.

Wenande said they are requesting \$200,000.00 over the next five years in installments of \$40,000.00 per year. The endowment will provide benefits for thousands of youth for years to come.

Burn Ban: Emergency Management Director Paul Scherschligt presented to the board an amendment to Section II of the existing burn ban.

Action 151430EMHS: A motion was made by Freng and seconded by Kettering to accept the amended Yankton County Burn Ban Resolution. All present voted aye; motion carried.

RESOLUTION 15-3

A Resolution by the Yankton County Board of Commissioners to appoint and set the compensation for the position of Yankton County Treasurer.

WHEREAS, the current Yankton County Treasurer, Pam Marchand has submitted her resignation in writing effective July 1, 2015.

WHEREAS, that written resignation has been appropriately filed in the office of the Yankton County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, SDCL 7-8-20 states that the County commission shall superintend and secure management of county offices in the best possible manner; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Yankton County and the citizens therein to assure the dispatch of prompt and accurate business; and

WHEREAS, the provisions set for in SDCL 3-4-2, 2-4-3, 3-4-6, 3-4-7 and All other provisions set forth in South Dakota Codified Law have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Yankton County Board of Commissioners that Patty Vavra, is appointed as Yankton County Treasurer to fill the unexpired term of Pam Marchand, effective July 1, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the compensation for such appointment shall be at the same level as the preceding Treasurer, beginning on July 1, 2015. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Liability Insurance: The Board discussed liability on using personal vehicles or County vehicles, traveling to County workshops and meetings. The Board also discussed the mileage rate for County employees.

County Seal: Commissioner Bodenstedt, along with Yankton County Register of Deeds Brian Hunhoff, presented to the board a report on implementing a Yankton County Seal.
