Dave Fedeler, Lake County Highway Superintendent announced today the seasonal road restrictions will become effective at 08:00 A.M. on February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 due to the unusual warm weather conditions. (SDCL 32-22-24). All hard surface and gravel roads are restricted to 7-Ton per axle.

Exception:

County Road #51 from SD Hwy #34 north for 7 miles restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

County Road #53 from County Road R22 (226 Street) north for 6 miles restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle

County Road #19 (462 AVE OFF SD HWY 34 (235 Street) 462 Ave, 461 Ave, & 461A Ave,) south on R19 for 3.64 miles restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

County Road #21 (461 Ave) at 461 Ave & 238 Street) south on R21 for 6 miles restricted to 80,000 pounds gross weight for any vehicle or combination of vehicles, 6-Ton per axle.

County Road #19 from South Dakota Hwy #34 north 2 miles WILL BE LEGAL LOAD.

County Road #20 from US Hwy 81 west for 4 1/2 miles WILL BE LEGAL LOAD.

County Road #43 from County Road #20 south on R43 for 1 mile: WILL BE LEGAL LOAD.

County Road #15 from SD Hwy #34 south for 6 miles WILL BE LEGAL LOAD.

County Road #16 from US Hwy 81 east for 5 miles then North on County Road #25 for 1/2 mile & County Road #23 east for 1/2 mile: WILL BE LEGAL LOAD.

Seasonal road restrictions will remain in effect until lifted by the Lake County Highway Superintendent.
