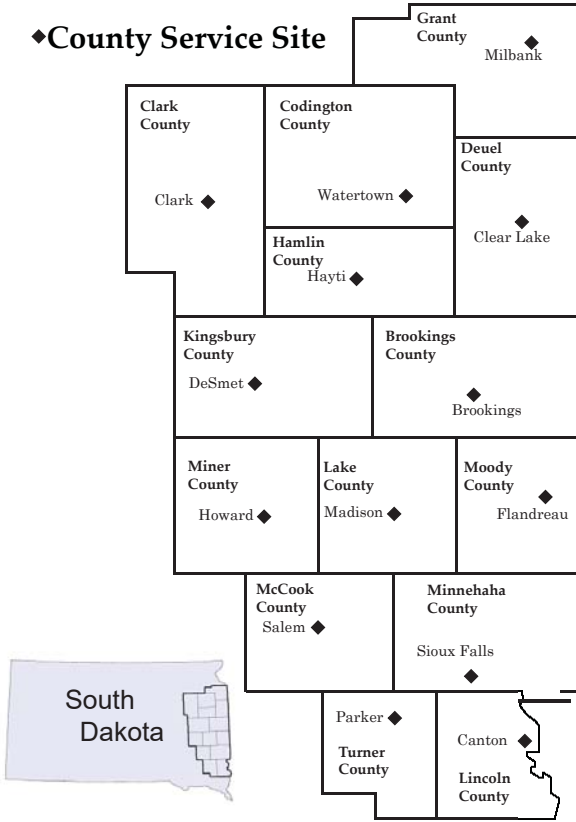

Spotlight Program

ICAP's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers eligible tax filers the opportunity to meet with IRS trained staff and volunteers from Dakota State University. Eligibility for this program is based on household income of below \$54,000. Assistance provided is confidential, with no cost e-filing, and each participant receives copies of their return for record-keeping purposes. Funding for the program is provided through an IRS grant and local funders including Brookings United Way, Watertown United Way and Interlakes United Way.

ICAP's VITA program originated in a few select locations in 2006 completing tax returns for 132 households. Since its inception, the program has expanded to all 14-counties. In 2018, ICAP completed tax returns for 764 households.

764 households qualified for **\$1,407,831** in federal tax credit through the VITA

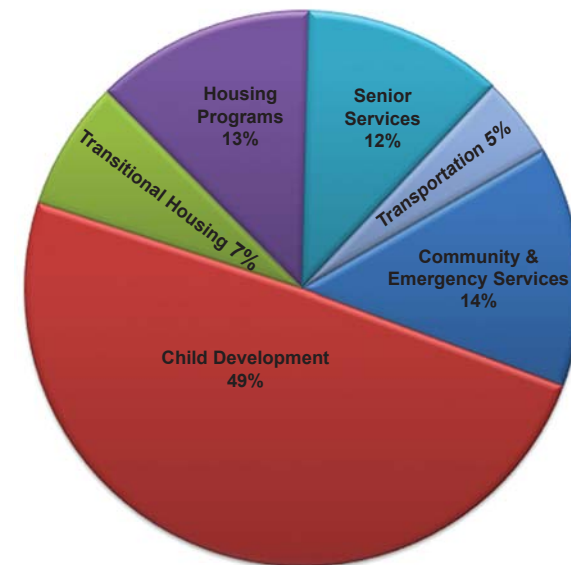
381 received assistance through Navigator

1,707 people obtained and/or maintained safe and affordable housing

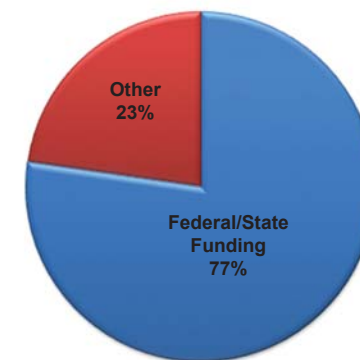
